### Word Bank

- **Activism:** Effort to promote reform
- **Amendment:** 18th Amendment (article added to the U.S. Constitution) outlawed alcohol nationwide, 21st Amendment repealed Prohibition
- **Bootleg:** To illegally make, sell or distribute something
- **Carry Nation:** An American activist who was a radical member of the temperance movement
- **Cherry Nose:** Nickname of Charlie Goe, who oversaw much of gangster Al Capone's activities in Des Moines
- **Corn:** Key ingredient for the manufacture of alcohol
- **Dry:** Components in support of prohibition
- **Kenyon:** Iowa Sen. William Kenyon was vocally in support of Prohibition
- **Law:** A system of rules
- **Moonshine:** Illegally distilled, smuggled beverage
- **Morals:** Principles of right and wrong
- **Movement:** An act of changing something
- **Prohibition:** Nationwide constitutional ban on alcoholic beverages from 1920 to 1933
- **Reform:** Make changes in order to improve it
- **Speakeasy:** An illicit store or nightclub
- **Temperance:** A social movement against the consumption of alcoholic beverages
- **U.S. Constitution:** Supreme law of the United States of America
- **Wet:** Components against Prohibition
