What started out to be a fine hot Sunday afternoon, gradually turned into cloudy weather and then in the late afternoon, as the ball game between the California-Oregon All-Stars and the Tule Lake All-Stars was in the eighth inning, the Worst dust-storm in the history of Tule Lake roared between the barracks and across the open stretches.

The thousands of people at the ballpark scattered like stampeding cattle when the dust Was seen rolling toward the field and when the storm did strike, the Project was blacked-out by the dust for about 30 minutes.
